Buddhist pilgrimage tour in Nepal designed by Nepal Kailash Trekking especially takes you around the main Buddhist pilgrimage sites of Nepal. This would be the perfect trip for those who are inquisitive about Buddhism since the trip imparts the details on the subject of Buddhism and its customs. Buddhist pilgrimage tour will take you on a trip giving us aged as well as transformed belief of Buddhism which presents an internal peace.

In the Kathmandu the valley you will make a trip as a Buddhist to Swoyambhunath, lying at the hillock which is also referred as the monkey temple and lets you capture the site of Kathmandu Valley from the top. You will also go around Boudhanath which is another stupa enlisted in World Heritage Site by UNESCO. The set of Boudhanath with completely enchant you with its tranquility and you will also notice monks performing certain rituals hymning religious songs in their holy dress totally devoting to Buddhism. You may also visit Namobuddha located on somewhat high land at a pleasant and isolated set which is also one of the holy Buddhist pilgrimage sites. This spot also has a myth that Buddha fed a tiger suffering from starvation offering his flesh to her with no hesitation. Likewise, you may also visit Kapan Monastery which is set in a Tibetan style.

Another major fascination of Buddhist pilgrimage tour is making a trip to Lumbini which is the birth place Buddha (The Lord Buddha). Here, you will go around Maya Devi temple; Ashoka Pillar erected in 249 BC by Indian Emperor Ashoka to honor his visit to the holy spot; and Puskarni Pond which holds the legend that Mayadevi took a bath in the pond before giving birth to Lord Buddha. Plus, visiting Tilaurakot lying 24km west of Lumbini would be worthwhile. It is believed to be the remnants of antique Kapilvastu, the childhood house of Siddhartha Gautam.
