

# Detail Itinerary

The Mardi Himal Nepal - Mardi Himal trek is one of the short trekking options in Nepal which fits best to those who have limited time yet want to get pleasure from the splendid trekking experience. Mardi Himal trekking trail is a comparatively newly trekking trail in Nepal, be found in the Annapurna area. It was formally opened for trekking in 2012 and is a less trodden route. Mardi Himal Nepal trek is a superb chance to walk up through very old rhododendron woods to the gigantic mountain faces. Particularly, you will spot the close-up views of Annapurna South, Hiunchuli, Ganga Purna, Machhapuchhre or Fishtail, Annapurna I as well as Mardi Himal itself.

[Mardi Himal base camp trek](#) takes you through the routes lying just east of the Annapurna Base Camp trek. Your path winds all the way through antique rhododendron jungles villages filled with houses made up of stones until you ascend out to 3,300 m. Mardi Himal Trekking is squeezed in between two admired trek routes in Annapurna Region- Ghorepani Poon Hill Trek and Annapurna Base Camp Trek. One of the captivating parts of the Mardi Himal Trek is witnessing the striking bird named Himalayan Mona which is also known as Danphe. It is a multicolored Himalayan bird signifying as the national bird of Nepal.

Mardi Himal trek designed by Nepal Kailash Trekking is a tranquil area in the Annapurna region as a new trekking trail in Nepal, where you can see very few trekkers and meet up welcoming local inhabitants. Also, you will notice a number of newly made lodges and enjoy homestay services at the houses built next to Mardi Himal ridge. There is also an available Mardi peak where you can climb without the special permit as well. The best time to go for Mardi Himal trek is throughout mid-September to early December. And, to go for Mardi Himal trek, you will require having a certain level of fitness though there is no direct ascending involved. Yet, you have to trek over a number of rocky regions.
