Simikot Kailash trekking via Rara Lake is upwards to the Khasa culture and settlement villages as well as alpine meadows, constituent parts are indistinguishable forests. Rara lake to Simkot Kailash trekking is the incredible views of foothills, arid lands, the lush forest as well as mountains. Rara lake, itself the biggest lake in Nepal and it lies in Rara national park in Mugu District of Nepal. This trekking follows upward to Karnali river which is the longest as well as flows West to East. Rara area is the home of birds, wild animals, and species of plants as well as the tree. This trekking can be done from Simikot - Humla to Mugu Rara lake and end at Jumla. There is no direct flight to Jumla from Kathmandu. This is why we must stay one night in Nepalgunj for next day early morning flight. It depends on whether so far.

This region people are Khasas, Brahmins, Byansis Thakuris, Shahi, Lama and they all depends on the agriculture occupational cast. This trekking is divided into three parts like Rara lake trekking, Humla or Simikot trekking and Kailash, Tibet trekking tour, this is why we can say it three in one trekking in Nepal. Of course, you can see blended culture in this trekking like Hindu and Buddhist Tibetan.
